**The district of Malasaña is home to Madrid's oldest 'churrería', where you can enjoy a traditional cup of hot chocolate with 'churros' (deep-fried dough) as you watch how they are made through the open kitchen.**

Churreria 1883 is an inviting place, combining old and new through details such as its false skylight, iron lamps, and a large window onto its kitchen and its chocolate-making machine. As you pull a stool up to one of the high tables, you can enjoy a breakfast or afternoon snack/tea, including bread served with tomato and oil, or with ham, croissants, sandwiches, toast with butter and jam or Nutella, pain au chocolat or waffles, among a number of delicious options.
