Chef Rubén Arnanz, also with a Michelin star under his belt, will open **19.86**; this dynamic, cosmopolitan boutique restaurant features an exclusive space where a limited number of diners can watch Arnanz at work.

At **Le Petit Dim Sum**, a new concept by the China Crown group, diners can choose from a wide variety of handmade dim sum dishes washed down with the best cocktails. Its founders, María Li Bao and Felipe Bao bring to Madrid an innovative, fresh take on the age-old essence and tradition of Chinese cuisine.

Thanks to its *savoir faire* in the culture, farming and distribution of this renowned French delicacy, **Daniel SORLUT** will serve oysters selected by the best chefs in the world, together with an exclusive selection of the country's wines and champagnes. Don't miss the restaurant's show-cooking experiences and collaborations with renowned chefs.

Finally, the 650-m2 multi-purpose **MAD Gourmets** will boast 20 unique gastronomic spaces serving a wide variety of specialities, from typical Spanish tapas to the latest international trends in gastronomy.
